ADUSA RELEASES QDRIVER QUEUE MANAGEMENT SYSTEM

New system interleaves, optimizes, multiple order channels into one queue

QDriver interleaves counter, kiosk, and mobile orders in one queue, so that all orders are processed using a first-in-first-out model. Estimated wait times and order processing times are calculated by the system using dynamic algorithms that adjust to real time conditions.
